The PEPPOL project

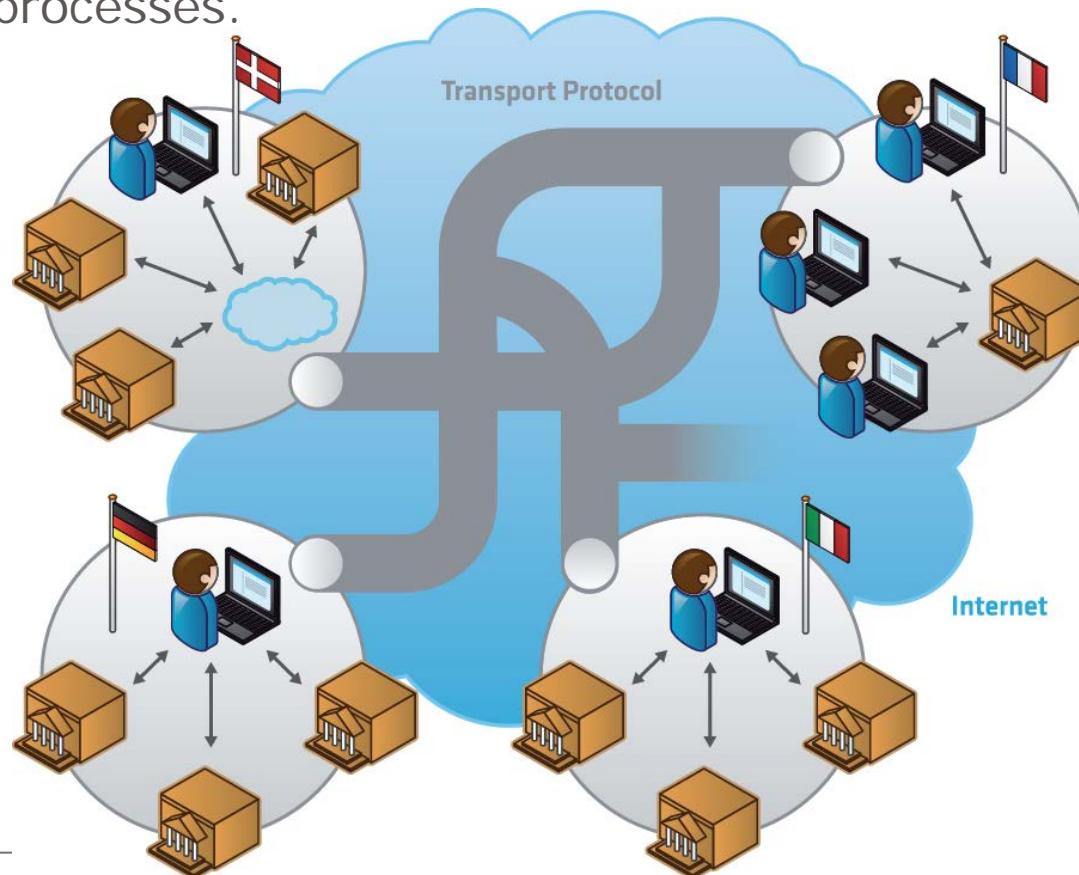


The PEPPOL project is the result of the European Competitiveness and Innovation Programme (CIP) ICT Policy Support Programme (ICTPSP) 2007 and 2009 Call for Proposals

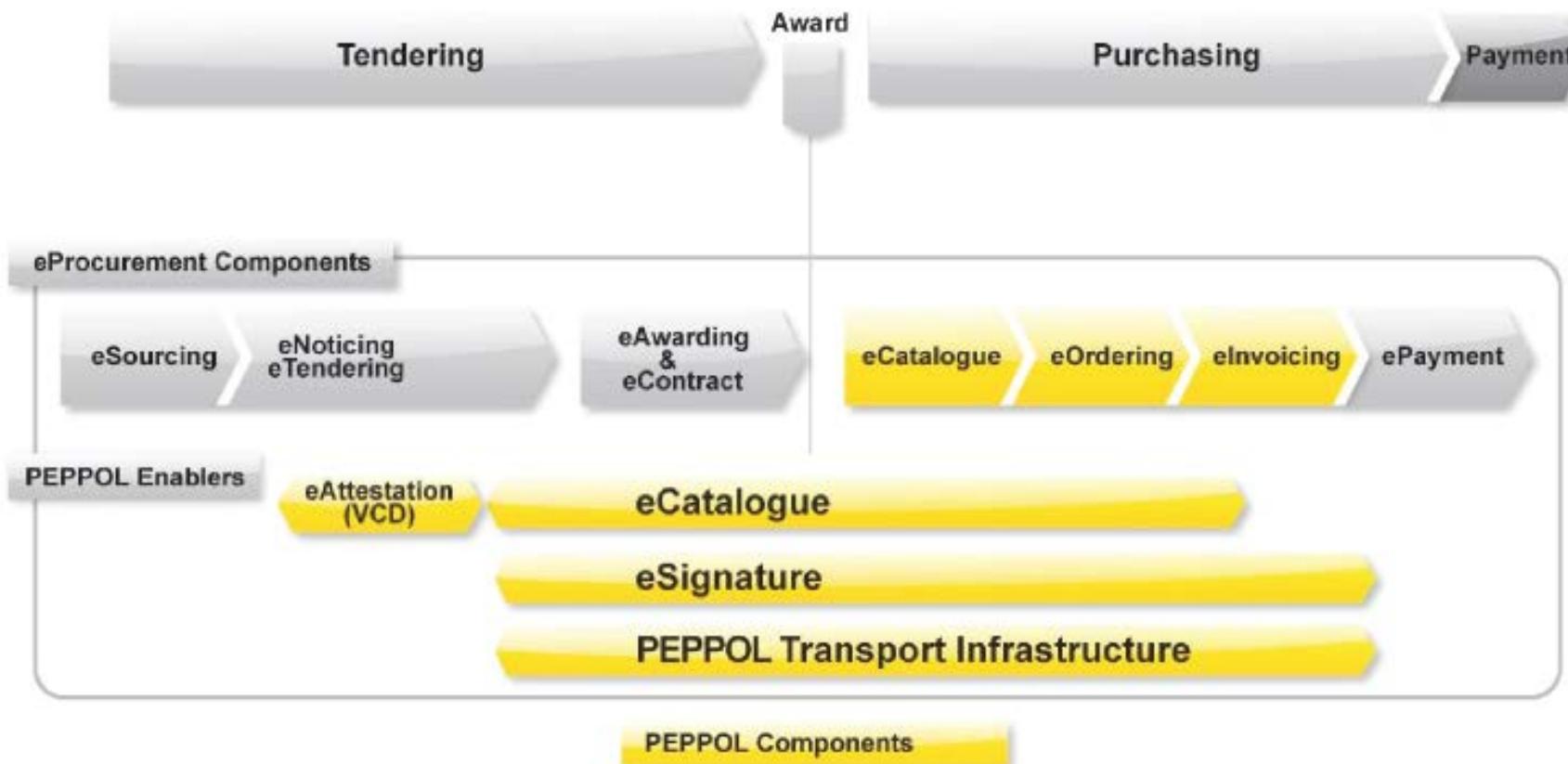
- ▶ Pilot A objective: Enabling EU-wide public eProcurement
- ▶ 50% EU contribution for achieving interoperability
- ▶ Coordinated by the Norwegian Agency for Public Management and eGovernment (Difi)
- ▶ Consortium and scope:
 - ▶ 18 beneficiaries from 11 countries
 - ▶ Total budget 30,8 M€
 - ▶ 8 work packages, <1.600 person months and 10 M€ on sub-contractors
 - ▶ Project start up: 1 May 2008, duration 48 months

The PEPPOL Vision

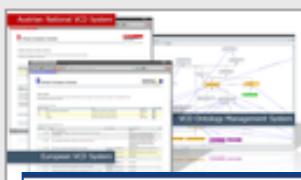
Any **supplier (incl. SMEs)** in the EU can **communicate electronically** with any **European contracting authority** for all procurement processes.

Building the PEPPOL community

Progress plan for building the PEPPOL community



- ▶ READY: Since May 2010, basic PEPPOL components and services are in place for a limited number of invited test pilot participants.
- ▶ PROVEN: From November 2010 a growing number of production pilots create an integrated community between PEPPOL consortium members, using PEPPOL to perform real business. Recruitment of non-PEPPOL consortium members as pilot participants evolves.
- ▶ IN USE: By the end of 2011, a substantial number of pilots performing real business through PEPPOL among both PEPPOL and non-PEPPOL consortium members.
- ▶ ESTABLISHED: By mid 2012, the PEPPOL Community expands beyond those recruited by PEPPOL to recruitment by commercial market driven adoption.
- ▶ UNIVERSAL: After mid 2012, a critical mass of adoption sees PEPPOL used by a majority of eProcurement communities across Europe.



Pilot Implementation

Pilot Implementation Support

- ▶ Original project structure organized vertically in areas that included activities from specification to piloting
- ▶ A Implementation Support Unit (ISU) operational form May 2011 to handle pilot coordination tasks across WPs
 - ▶ Delivery and Support of Pilots
 - ▶ Harmonized view of the PEPPOL product
 - ▶ One-stop mechanism to support transfer of experiences
- ▶ ISU supports piloting within and outside the PEPPOL consortium
 - ▶ ICT industry and e-procurement communities
 - ▶ Public sector buyers and their suppliers

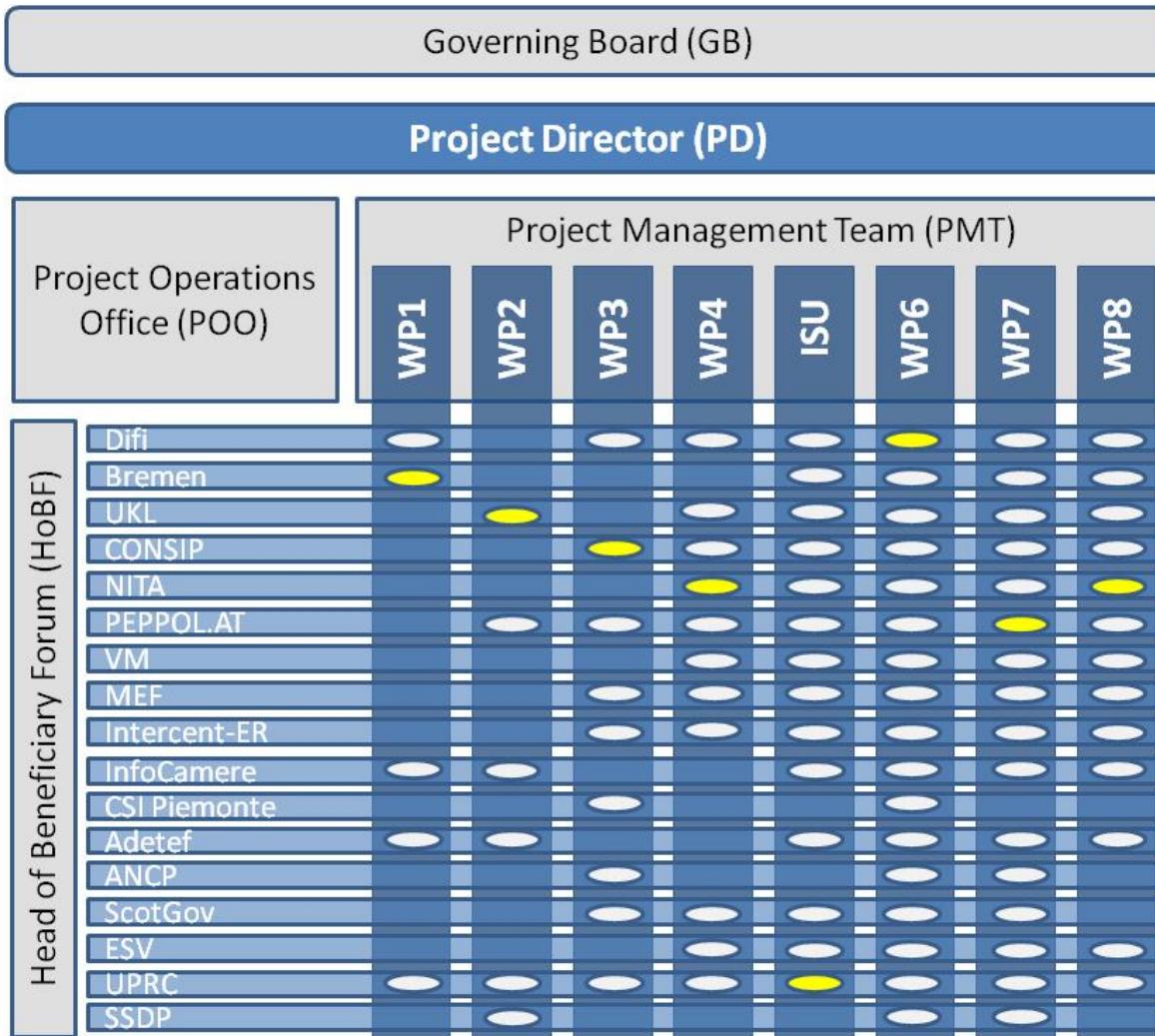

- ▶ Erfaring fra nasjonal e-handelssatsing fra 1999
- ▶ Deltakelse i EU-arbeid med e-handel fra 2001
- ▶ Deltakelse i nordisk og europeisk standardiseringsarbeid ift e-handel fra 2003
- ▶ Deltakelse i forberedelser til CIP ICTPSP Pilot A på e-handel fra 2005
- ▶ Politisk og økonomisk støtte til deltagelse, og mulig ledelse, i fra 2006
- ▶ Aktiv konsortiebygging fra tidlig 2007

Samordning på tvers av land (II)

PEPPOL er i første rekke samarbeid mellom nasjonale innkjøpsmyndigheter, men også IKT-myndigheter

- ▶ Fase 1: Skape konsensus og lage spesifikasjoner
- ▶ Fase 2: Lage programvare og andre komponenter for å sikre interoperabilitet
- ▶ Fase 3: Pilotering
 - ▶ Konseptvalidering
 - ▶ Testpilot
 - ▶ Produksjonspilot
- ▶ I parallel: Standardisering gjennom deltagelse i CEN WS BII/BII2 og etablering av OASIS TC BDX
- ▶ I parallel: Påvirke politikkutforming og anskaffelsesregelverk

Hva har vi oppnådd?

- Leveranser (rapporter, programvare, annet) iht plan og budsjett
- Fungerende løsninger, faktisk bruk
- Nasjonale implementeringer med levetid utover prosjektperioden
- Rolle som viktigste EU-initiativ ift offentlig e-handel i arbeid med nytt innkjøpsdirektiv og Digital Agenda 2020 mm.

Noen erfaringer

- ▶ Viktigheten av konsortiepartnere med reell påvirkningskraft og vilje til å implementere, ikke bare interesse for prosjektmidler
- ▶ Ledelsesmessig og administrativt krevende
 - ▶ Utvidelse av konsortiet i to runder
 - ▶ Forlengelse av prosjektperioden i to runder
 - ▶ Partnere som forlater konsortiet pga finanskrise
- ▶ Aktiv deltagelse i posisjonering/samarbeid mellom ulike EU-enheter og standardiseringsorganisasjoner er nødvendig, men også ift ulike nasjonale enheter
- ▶ Fokus på “Long term sustainability” og varig påvirkning fra dag én
